## June 2017 \$1.3 Million Take It or Trade It Rules

- 1. The *Promotion* is valid at the following seven (7) participating properties: The Orleans, Gold Coast, Suncoast, Sam's Town, California, Fremont and Main Street Station.
- 2. Participants must be B Connected members. B Connected membership is free and available at the B Connected Club. Must be 21 years of age or more to be a B Connected member.
- 3. The *Drawing* will be held at participating properties every Friday and Saturday beginning June 2 July 1, 2017.
- 4. Participants may earn entries into the virtual *Drawing* at any of the seven (7) participating properties beginning at 3:00 a.m. May 30, 2017 and ending July 1, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. for Main Street Station, 6:00 p.m. for Orleans and Sam's Town, and at 8:00 p.m. for Gold Coast, Suncoast, California and Fremont.
- 5. Slot machine players receive one (1) virtual entry for every ten (10) base points earned each day with their B Connected card properly inserted in their machines. - 9. All drawing entries are "virtual" and must be activated (electronically deposited into our virtual drawing drum) at a casino promotional kiosk at the property where entries are earned. Participants must activate their entries at any kiosk at least fifteen (15) minutes prior to the drawing time on the day of the drawing. Entries earned during the fifteen (15) minute period prior to the drawing will not be eligible for activation in that pending drawing. 11. **California and Fremont** will each hold one (1) drawing on Friday and one (1) drawing on Saturday, where three (3) winners will be selected in each drawing. Drawing and the cash envelope selections will take place at the following locations and times

**California:** 2<sup>nd</sup> floor tournament area, 8:15 p.m. Participants from Main Street Station and California Hotel may activate their entries beginning at 4:00 p.m. on drawing dates at the California Only.

Main Street Station: Participants will need to check in at the California after 4:00 p.m. on drawing dates

**Fremont**: B Connected, 8:15 p.m. Participants may activate their entries beginning at 4:00 p.m. on drawing dates.

- 12. There is a maximum of 10,000 entries, per day, per person, for the drawing.
- 13. Participants must be present to win and have three (3) minutes to identify themselves once their name has been called. Valid identification and B Connected card is required for all prize winners. Valid identification is defined as a current valid form of one of the following: state issued driver's license with picture, state issued identification card with picture, military identification card with picture, or government issued passport. If winner is not a U.S citizen, a current valid passport or alien registration card is required. After the three (3) minutes have expired, a new name will be drawn until a winner has been identified.

- 14. Each winner will be given a choice to decide if they want to take the initial cash prize offered or trade it for a chance to choose one envelope out of seven from the Take it or Trade It game board. At Orleans, Gold Coast, Suncoast and Sam's Town, three (3) prizes are lower than offered amount, one (1) prize equal to the offered amount, and three (3) prizes are higher than the offered amount which includes the top prize of \$5,000. At California/Main Street Station and Fremont, four (4) prizes are lower than offered amount, one (1) prize equal to the offered amount, and two (2) prizes are higher than the offered amount which includes the top prize of \$5,000. - 27. By participating in the *Promotion or Drawing*, each winner gives Boyd Gaming permission to take photographs of each winner and use his or her name and/or likeness for advertising and publicity purposes for no compensation.
