#### HISTORY OF DELTA DOWNS RACETRACK CASINO & HOTEL

The original Delta Downs was located in St. Joseph, La. and was opened in 1964. It was built by Lee Berwick, who loved American Quarter Horses and wanted a place for him and other owners to compete.

Berwick purchased 240 acres of land in Vinton, La. in the early 1970's and began to build a new racetrack. Featuring a six-furlong oval, the track was designed to accommodate mainly Quarter Horses. It included 1,200 stalls and opened to public on Sept. 20, 1973.

Throughout the years, Delta Downs' Quarter Horse season has drawn some of the sport's top athletes. AQHA champions like Mr Jess Perry, Develop a Plan, Johnny Vittoro, Kool Kue Baby, Oak Tree Special and Vals Fortune have all competed at Delta Downs.

Berwick owned and operated Delta Downs until 1999, when it was sold to Shawn Scott and a group of investors.

Scott and other horseracing interests lobbied the state to get slot machines legalized at racetracks in order to boost horseracing purses. In a relatively short period of time, the law was changed and plans were made to place a casino at Delta Downs.

Before the new casino opened its doors, Delta Downs was sold once again, this time to Boyd Gaming Corporation. The company took over operation of Delta Downs in 2001 and opened the casino, with nearly 1,500 slot machines, in mid-February of 2002.

The new casino generated record purses at Delta Downs. During the upcoming 2008-2009 Thoroughbred Meeting, the track plans to offer over \$200,000 in daily purse money during its 88-day season.

The increase in purses has allowed Delta Downs to develop one of the nation's richest events, Boyd Gaming's \$750,000 Delta Jackpot Stakes.

The Delta Jackpot, which will be renewed for the sixth time on Friday, Dec. 5, became the first graded Thoroughbred race ever contested at Delta Downs after the North American Graded Stakes Committee granted the event grade III status in 2005.

The annual Jackpot program will take on even more importance this year as Boyd Gaming's \$500,000 Delta Princess Stakes Power by Youbet.com will also carry grade III status for the first time in its six-year history. The Princess is a one-mile test for 2-year-old fillies which draws top equine talent from coast to coast each year.



#### **MAP OF DELTA DOWNS**


#### **FACILITY MAP**

#### **TWO FOR THE MONEY IN JACKPOT**

The 2007 edition of Boyd Gaming's \$1 Million Delta Jackpot Stakes (Grade III) featured one of the most exciting and dramatic finishes of the year in Thoroughbred racing. After 1-1/16 miles of grueling competition, Z Humor and Turf War were inseparable at the wire and wound up in a dead heat for the win.

After facing eventual Eclipse Award winning Champion 2-year-old War Pass in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile just five weeks earlier, Zayat Stables' Z Humor was sent to Delta Downs along with Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott and nationally prominent jockey Garrett Gomez. The trio was poised for success and the wagering public agreed, making the Kentucky-bred son of Distorted Humor a short price of just 3-2 on the toteboard.

At the other end of the pari-mutuel spectrum was Turf War, who was dismissed by race fans at 39-1 after making a lengthy sojourn to Vinton from Toronto, Canada, where he had most recently competed at Woodbine racetrack. The property of Woodford Racing LLC did have a local connection however, as Louisiana native and Kentucky Derby winning rider Calvin Borel had accepted the Jackpot mount from trainer Mark Casse.

Not only were the eventual winners sent off at very different odds, they also took completely opposite paths to the finish line during the race. Z Humor broke sharply and was intent on staying close to pacesetter St. Joe until he reached the homestretch. Turf War was taken back to last by Borel and ran nearly 17 lengths behind the leader early on.

As the field approached the top of the lane, Gomez and Z Humor were well placed while saving ground on the inside. Their journey to victory seemed almost complete with only an eighth of a mile to go. In contrast, Borel's work on Turf War had just begun with a sustained rally from far behind. But a wall of horses still stood between them and the finish line while precious time was beginning to run out.

In a desperate move to keep his mount rolling, Borel guided Turf War to the middle of the racetrack, nearly eight paths off the rail entering the stretch. For a jockey who had made a name for himself by taking the short way home, this had to feel awkward, but desperate times were calling for desperate measures.

As the field straightened away in the final strides, it became clear that this would be no walk in the park for either Z Humor or Turf War, as eventual Delta Downs leading rider and record breaker Gerard Melancon burst on the scene with Jean Lafitte hero Golden Yank. The pair finally got clear sailing after being bottled up for nearly a quarter of a mile around the far turn.

With a little more than a sixteenth of a mile to race the stage was set for a breathtaking finish. Z Humor had grabbed a one-length lead before Golden Yank appeared to his outside and Turf War started to bear down in the center of the track while drifting in through the stretch. Gomez, Melancon and Borel each knew victory was within their grasp, but neither was gaining an advantage as the finish line drew ever closer.

About fifty feet from the wire, the trio came together and ran nearly shoulder to shoulder until they reached the finish line. Their close proximity only served to strengthen each horse's resolve, and the pitched battle continued right to the end.

Just a few short moments after the race, the photo finish sign went up on the toteboard and the placing judges began their job of inspecting the ultra tight finish. It was pretty clear that Golden Yank had finished third, but it was impossible to tell if either Z Humor or Turf War had stretched out their nose enough to earn the \$600,000 first-place paycheck.

Meanwhile, while Melancon was pulling up his mount after the race, he felt as though his mount was compromised while racing in tight quarters nearing the finish. He immediately claimed foul against both of his rivals. That action caused even more drama because the winner was yet to be determined and the stewards would have to scrutinize the drive to the wire by means of video tape.

The placing judges eventually took down the photo finish sign and a dead heat was announced. The stewards also disallowed the claim of foul and the race was declared official.

Relieved and exalted, the winning connections celebrated their accomplishment on the track apron while Gomez and Borel both smiled and offered high fives to each other while waiting to have their pictures taken in the winner's circle.

There may never be another finish that matches the excitement of last year's Delta Jackpot Stakes, but you never know. This year's big race will take place on Friday, December 5 along with Boyd Gaming's \$500,000 Delta Princess Stakes Powered by Youbet.com (Grade III) and four other added money events.

#### BY THE LIGHT DOMINATES; PRINCESS TO CARRY GRADE III STATUS IN 2008

The 2007 running of Boyd Gaming's \$300,000 Delta Princess Stakes Powered by Youbet.com turned into a runaway for East Coast invader By the Light, who proved too much to handle for nine rivals in the one-mile affair.

Under jockey Rafael Bejarano, the New York-bred daughter of Malibu Moon stalked a rapid pace set by Miss Missile and rider Justin Shepherd, who had traveled the first quarter-mile in :22.23 and the initial half-mile in :46.78.

The taxing pace took its toll on Miss Missile, who had entered the richest annual offering for females at Delta Downs off a resounding score in the \$100,000 My Trusty Cat Stakes just four weeks earlier.

When the field entered the homestretch, Bejarano was sitting on a missile of his own, as By the Light hit her best stride with 1/8th of a mile to race and proceeded to blow by her front-running rival with ease.

Bejarano knew a win was inevitable as the final yards melted away. His bay mount increased her margin to 5-1/4 lengths at the finish line while Miss Missile held second by 1-1/2 lengths over late-running Lady On Holiday. The final time for eight furlongs over a fast track was 1:40.21.

By the Light's victory at Delta Downs proved to be the richest victory of her career, as she banked at tidy sum of \$180,000 for the effort. It also turned out to be her first win against unrestricted competition. During the first three tallies of her career she defeated horses in her home state at Belmont Park and Finger Lakes while racing against New York-breds only.

By the Light was saddled by trainer Richard, Dutrow, Jr., who would eventually saddle 2008 Kentucky Derby hero Big Brown.

Dutrow has been very selective while mapping out By the Light's career. Since her trip to Vinton last December, the talented runner has won two more stakes in New York and finished second to Eclipse Award winning filly Indian Blessing in the Grade I \$250,000 Prioress Stakes on July 5 at Saratoga.

The Princess Stakes was granted grade III status and the purse was increased to \$500,000 for 2008. Those changes will mean an even stronger race card on Friday, December 5 when the track also hosts Boyd Gaming's \$750,000 Delta Jackpot (Gr. III), and four other added-money events on a night that will feature total purse money of more than \$1.6 million.

#### LOUISIANA PREMIER NIGHT

One of the most exciting race programs each year at Delta Downs is Louisiana Premier Night, which will enjoy its fifth renewal on Saturday, February 7, 2009.

Louisiana Premier Night brings together the best Louisiana-bred horses to compete in 10 stakes races with combined purse money of \$1 million. The annual event celebrates equine talent from the Bayou State while attracting large crowds who enjoy heartpounding athletic competition.

Last year's edition of Louisiana Premier Night featured a sharp performance in the Championship, another victory by a track record holder in the Sprint, and a dead heat to wrap up the night in the Gentlemen Starter.

Heiligbrodt Racing Stables' Magic Sunset proved best in the \$200,000 LAPN Championship with jockey Donald Simington in the saddle. The James Hudson trainee was sent to the post at odds of 4-5 along with entry-mate Hallway.

Magic Sunset did not disappoint as he stalked the pace early before running down the leaders turning for home. His winning margin turned out to be 1-3/4 lengths over Z Storm, who was attempting to win his second consecutive LAPN event after scoring a big win in the 2006 Gentlemen Starter.

Whispering Oaks Farm, LLC's All Wired Up was also favored when he stepped onto the track for last year's LAPN Sprint. The Brandon Marks trainee earned his favoritism by setting a track record of :57.24 for five furlongs while taking the \$50,000 Zydeco Stakes on opening night of the meeting and recording four wins from five previous starts in Vinton, Louisiana.

Under jockey Joseph Patin, All Wired up burst from post position four and immediately took command by over a length heading into the far turn. When the field reached the top of the stretch, he was in total command and just needed to hold off a late charge by Myoldmansam, who only got within a length of the winner at the finish line.

With nine of the 10 LAPN races in the books, only the \$55,000 Gentlemen Starter was left on program. But fans who stuck around witnessed the most thrilling stretch drive of the evening as Robert Asaro Enterprises, Inc.'s Simma Down and D. L. M. Racing, Darrin & L. Menard's Joe's Majesty battled tooth and nail before hitting the finish line in a dead heat.

The exhilarating climax to the Gentlemen Starter proved that Louisiana is a hotbed of Thoroughbred racing and Delta Downs becomes its center stage each February. Magic Sunset
