LIVE RACING SCHEDULE

Delta Downs will conduct the second of 22 weeks of live Thoroughbred racing this Wednesday through Saturday. Post times each night during the 88-day season are at 5:45 p.m.

The track's 2011-2012 meeting will run through March 17. The only exception to the post time schedule will occur on Saturday, November 19, when a special afternoon program will take place during the ninth running of the \$1,000,000 Delta Downs Jackpot (Gr. III). Post time on Jackpot Day will be at 1:15 p.m.



The richest and most important race of the year takes place in just three weeks on Saturday, November 19. It's the \$1,000,000 Delta Downs Jackpot (Gr. III) for 2-year-olds seeking a huge paycheck and a possible starting spot in next year's Kentucky Derby.

This year's program will include eight stakes and over \$2 million in total purse money. There will be a special first post time of 1:15 p.m. on Jackpot Day.

MY ADONIS TAKES HUGE STEP TOWARD \$1,000,000 DELTA DOWNS JACKPOT

George and Lori Hall's 2-year-old colt, My Adonis, proved he belongs in next month's \$1,000,000 Delta Downs Jackpot (Gr. III) by winning last Saturday night's \$200,000 Jean Lafitte Stakes at Delta Downs.

The victory for My Adonis came in his stakes debut. The Kentucky-bred son of Breeders' Cup Classic winner Pleasantly Perfect broke his maiden on September 24 at Monmouth Park. My Adonis is conditioned by this year's Belmont Stakes winning trainer, Kelly Breen, who is no stranger to Delta Downs Jackpot Day.

In 2008 Breen finished second in the big race with West Side Bernie. In 2009 he sent out Truth and Justice in the \$500,000 Delta Downs Princess (Gr. III) on the under card after taking the My Trusty Cat with her a few weeks earlier. And last year he saddled Sweet Ducky, who finished fourth in the Jackpot to Gourmet Dinner.

Breen knows a victory on Jackpot Day will set his charge up for a run for the roses next May.

"We see this as a win and you're in race," said Breen. "Although it isn't technically that way, the \$600,000 in graded earnings will get you into the starting gate for the Kentucky Derby, so that's what we're aiming for."

CITIZEN ADVOCATE WIRES THE FIELD IN MY TRUSTY CAT

The first stakes race of the season, the \$200,000 My Trusty Cat, went to White Hall Lane Farm's Citizen Advocate on Saturday night under jockey Luis Jurado.



After breaking from post position 10 in the seven-furlong test for 2-year-old fillies, Citizen Advocate cleared the field and set all the pace while going gate-to-wire in victory.

The win by Citizen Advocate, a Florida-bred daughter of Proud Citizen, marked her fourth in a row and it was her third straight tally in stakes company.

The David Vivian trainee has also won stakes on three different surfaces. On July 31 she broke her maiden on dirt at Calder before taking the Catcharisingstar Stakes on the turf at the same track in late August. On October 1 she won the Presque Isle Debutant on a synthetic surface before coming to Delta Downs for her My Trusty Cat triumph last week.

Citizen Advocate will now attempt to become the first horse to win the My Trusty Cat and the \$500,000 Delta Downs Princess (Gr. III) when she goes postward on November 19.

FANS PREPARE FORANOTHER \$100,000ALL STAKES PICK 4

In addition to great racing on Delta Downs Jackpot Day, November 19, race fans can also take a shot at a big payoff with the \$100,000 guaranteed Pick 4 wagering pool. The bet will take place on races 4-7, which includes the \$1,000,000 Delta Downs Jackpot (Gr. III) and the \$500,000 Delta Downs Princess (Gr. III) along with two other added-money events.

Last year's Delta Downs Jackpot Pick 4 bet returned a whopping \$5,551.60 for a \$2 ticket with the winning combination of 8-6-8-1. The Delta Downs Jackpot Day Pick 4 record payoff came in 2006 when Birdbirdistheword anchored the bet when it paid a staggering \$22,225.80!!



THE NEXT STAKES RACES TAKE PLACE ON NOVEMBER 5

With all eyes on Delta Downs Jackpot Day coming up on November 19, fans can whet their appetite for the big day with more stakes racing next week. The track will host a pair of \$100,000 races for Louisiana-breds on Saturday, November 5.

The Magnolia and the Gold Cup will take center stage next week. The Magnolia is for older fillies and mares going one mile. The Gold Cup is also run at a mile and will feature 3-year-olds and older as well.

The Magnolia and the Gold Cup have each seen multiple winners over the years. Zarb's Ballerina won the Magnolia during the 2007-2008 season as well as during the 2009-2010 meeting. The Gold cup has been won by Costa Rising twice, in 2006-2007 and in 2007-2008, and by Snug on two occasions, 2008-2009 and in 2010-2011.

MCMAHON AND SAENZ LEAD THE WAY

C. J. McMahon and Diego Saenz started of the new season with six wins a piece last week to tie for the lead in the jockey standings after four days of action.

McMahon is the son of long time Delta Downs Quarter Horse jockey Charles McMahon and is in the first year of his career. The apprentice has been hot since he began riding and should be a force to deal with all season long.



Saenz won his first local riding title at Delta Downs in 2009-2010 when he booted home 108 winners and his mounts accounted for over \$2.3 million in earnings.
