. HORSES OVER THE AGE OF ELEVEN WHICH DID NOT WIN A RACE THE PREVIOUS YEAR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RACE AT EVD.

2. ALL HORSES MUST HAVE A NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A ZERO DATE.

MAIDEN ELIGIBILITY

1. MAIDENS OVER THE AGE OF SIX YEARS OLD WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RACE AT EVD.

*APPLICATIONS WITH A BALANCED STABLE (MAIDENS TO WINNERS RATIO) WILL BE PREFERRED.

No Pets allowed. Do not ship without confirmation. Current Coggins Test required. No substitutions without approval.

ENTRANCE INTO STABLE AREA

- 1. 30 Day Certificate of Veterinary Inspection
- 2. Vaccination Records for EHV1
- 3. Current Coggins Test required (For Complete Details see reverse side #17).

READ CAREFULLY

Prior to entering the State of Louisiana, Horses must have a current Veterinarian Health Certificate and have a negative Coggins Test. Conditions of Permit to Stable Horses at Evangeline Downs Racetrack Casino and Hotel

- 1. Evangeline Downs (EVD) reserves the right to refuse the application for stable space in whole or in part or refuse the acceptance of any entry into any race for any reason or cause and without notice to the undersigned.
- 2. The rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Racing Commission (LSRC) and EVD shall govern this meeting and all parties shall abide by such. All disputes will be decided by EVD or the Stewards of the meet as the case may be, and such decisions upon all points shall be final.
- 3. Applicant agrees to enter and race all horses which have been granted stall space at EVD, in all races for which they are eligible unless the Racing Secretary agrees otherwise. Any Trainers not abiding by this may be asked to vacate any or all stalls. Fitness to race shall be determined by the track vet or the state vet. In accepting stalls, Applicant agrees to stable at EVD for the entire meet.
- 4. Applicant agrees that horses will remain only in the stalls that have been allotted, and that the loaning of vacant stalls is prohibited without exception. All empty stalls must be turned in to the EVD Stall Superintendent.
- 5. Applicant agrees to keep stalls, stable area, and tack rooms clean and in good condition. Applicant also agrees to put manure in the manure bins and to keep the manure bin area clean and free of debris. In addition, Applicant agrees to strip all stalls assigned of all bedding material prior to vacating of stalls. A charge of \$25.00 per stall may be charged if stalls are not cleaned and raked to the satisfaction of EVD.
- 6. Applicant agrees to deposit \$100.00 for each tack room. If tack rooms are found to be in good condition prior to departure, EVD will refund the deposit to the applicant. There will be a charge of \$50.00 for lost room keys. Any damages to the barn area or the tack rooms will be repaired at the expense of the applicant.
- 7. Applicant agrees that any alterations (drilling holes, nails, painting, attachments of any kind, etc.) to the tack room, feed rooms, barn or barn area must be approved by the Stall Superintendent. Applicant also agrees that any heating, cooking, cooling, or electrical devices must be approved by the Stall Superintendent. All box fans must be approved by the Stall Superintendent and equipped with protective guards.
- 8. Applicant agrees (A) to be familiar and make employees familiar with the LSRC rules of racing, the rules of EVD, and the racing officials of the meet; (B) to comply, and require employees to comply with LSRC rules, the rules of EVD, and the decisions of the LSRC, EVD, and the racing officials of the meet; (C) to vacate stalls and move all horses, equipment and personnel off of the premises of EVD within 48 hours of being requested to do so.
- 9. Hurricane Evacuation Notice: In the event EVD is mandated to evacuate the area by St. Landry Parish Officials all horses and backside personnel will also be required to vacate the backside once notified within 24 hours or otherwise instructed.
- 10. All horses stabled at EVD must be eligible to race at EVD, with the exception of approved pony horses.
- 11. No dogs or other animals allowed in the barn area.
- 12. No firearms will be allowed on the property of EVD.
- 13. All owners, trainers, jockeys, and stable employees must be licensed by the LSRC.
- 14. EVD assumes no responsibility for any foal certificates or silks left for more than seven (7) days after the meet ends.
- 15. All hoses must be equipped with automatic shutoff nozzles.
- 16. No personal walking wheels will be allowed on track. Walkers may be leased at the track.
- 17. All horses stabled at EVD must have a current heath certificate dated within 30 days and a current Coggins test dated within 12 months. Additionally, each horse seeking entrance to the stable area must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by a licensed accredited veterinarian within 30 days of arrival at the track stating the horses temperature (101.5 F or less) and a record of vaccination for Equine Herpes Virus Type 1 (EHV1) administrated not less than 14 days but no more than 90 days prior to arrival. Date of vaccination and specific product used must be noted on the CVI.
- 18. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all of its respective employees have proper documentation verifying legal status and employability in the United States of America. By

signing this agreement, applicant agrees to indemnify, defend and save the Property (including officers, directories, employees and agents of the property) harmless for, from and against any and all claims, suits and liabilities based on the legal status of its employees.

- 19. Applicant agrees that neither EVD nor any of its officers, employees, or agents shall be liable for any loss, damage, death, or injury of any kind to applicant or applicants employees, agents, invitees, jockeys, or members of any of their respective families, or to any of the property or animals, regardless of whether such injury, loss, death, or damage is caused by a condition of the premises and/or any negligent act or omission of EVD or any of its officers, agents, or employees or from any other cause. Applicant hereby specifically and knowingly assumes all risk of such injury, loss, death, or damage fully and completely.
- 20. Applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless EVD, its' officers, employees, and agents from any and all liabilities, claims, and demands or damages, injuries, death, loss, cost, or expense, any claim or suit which may arise out of or in connection with or relative to the foregoing and shall pay all attorneys fees and expenses in connection therewith.
- 21. Not withstanding any provisions of paragraphs 19 and 20 of this Agreement to the contrary, Applicant may elect to substitute the following provisions in lieu of paragraphs 19 and 20 hereof and such shall govern from the receipt by EVD of written notice by certified U.S. Mail of such election by Applicant.
- 22. Ban on horse slaughter: Any owner or trainer based at EVD who sells a horse for slaughter that was previously stabled at EVD will have their stalls permanently revoked.

Together with foals certificates, Applicant shall file with the Racing Secretary's Office certificates of insurance from insurers acceptable to EVD showing that the Applicant is the named insured on (a) a commercial general liability insurance policy having minimum limits of not less than \$500,000 for personal injury and property damage and (b) a worker's compensation policy issued thru the LHBPA. Such policies shall provide coverage for EVD entire live race meet and shall provide a clause providing that such policies shall not be cancelled without at least thirty (30) days prior written notice to EVD by certified mail. No policies may cover more than one trainer.

This is not a lease of any space, but is merely a revocable permit on the terms and conditions outlined. The undersigned, as part of this application for stabling of any or all of the horses listed herein at EVD agrees to these terms and conditions. Trainer must sign below before application will be processed.

I certify that all information is true and correct, and that I have read and agree with all of the above conditions, provisions, and rules for stabling horses at EVD, and that I agree to remain stabled at EVD for the entire meet.
