

- 1. This promotion is valid at The Gold Coast Hotel & Casino in Tournament Alley, located next to TGI Friday's. Tournament hours are 11am-7pm every Thursday.
- 2. Participants must have a valid B Connected card to be eligible. Beginning at 2:00am B Connected Card members who earn fifty (50) same day base points may earn one (1) free entry, earn an additional (100) same day points for a second entry on Thursdays to be eligible to play in the Free Thursday Video Poker Tournament.
- 3. Vouchers may be printed at any promotional kiosk and must be presented to Tournament Alley during posted tournament times. Vouchers must be printed between 2:00am and 6:45pm on the Thursday the points were earned. Lost vouchers will not be replaced.
- 4. Slot points do not include point multipliers, bonus points or point transfers. It is the player's responsibility to make sure his or her valid B Connected card is properly inserted in the slot machine to earn slot points. Player keeps the points earned and receives a free entry to the Thursday tournament.
- 5. Qualified participants will be allowed to play one (1) session consisting of fifteen (15) minutes and one thousand two hundred fifty (1250) credits, the play will determine whether the time or credits allotted expires first. Participants who earn a second entry will play a second session consisting of the same terms. The highest score will be used for purposes of prize determination. Participants may only win one time per week.
- 6. The actual machine played will be determined by a random drawing from the available machines prior to the start of each participant's. Double-Double will be the game theme for the tournament.
- 7. At the end of the session, a scorekeeper will record the session score and ask the participant to verify the score by signing the score sheet. Entries into the tournament are not transferrable. The person who earns the entry must play the full fifteen (15) minute round.
- 8. All prizes will be paid in slot dollars in the following amounts:

1st place \$500 3rd-5th place \$100 2nd place \$200 6th-35th place \$50

- 9. If any tie scores occur, which affect prize money to be awarded, the two money totals will be combined and split between the two entrants. EXAMPLE: Entrants "A" & "B" receive tied scores for the first place (\$500) and the second place (\$200). The combined total of \$700 will be evenly divided, with each entrant receiving \$350.
- 10. Winning scores will be posted in Tournament Alley at 11:59pm on Thursday. The prize money will be loaded to the winner's B Connected account in Slot Dollars.
- 11. Winners will have (48) hours to play the slot dollars (until 11:59pm on Saturday). Slot dollars not used within that (48) hour period will be void.
- 12. All B Connected rules apply.
- 13. Additional entries may be awarded through other marketing programs such as, but not limited to, Direct Mail, Email, Text or B Connected Online.
- 14. If your machine malfunctions, please raise your hand and notify a tournament official immediately. He or she will decide whether you continue to play on that machine or move to a spare machine. (If available) In the event of a power outage, please remain at your machine.
- 15. Management may disqualify any person for any prize based upon fraud, dishonesty, violation of promotional rules or other misconduct whether or not related to this promotion.
