



World Series of Poker Circuit – September 4 - 15, 2014

- The IP Poker Room will be running \$365 No Limit Hold'em Tournaments from September 4 – 15, 2014.
- Players will start with 10,000 in tournament chips.
- \$365 fee (\$300 prize pool + \$65 administrative fee)
- This is a two-day tournament. Day 2 will resume at 3:00 p.m. the following day.
- Tournaments starting at 12 p.m. will play 18 levels.
- Tournaments starting at 2 p.m. will play 15 levels.
- Tournaments starting at 5 p.m. will play 12 levels.
- Day 1 will have a break every 2 hours with a dinner break after 12 levels.
- Day 2 will have a break every 2 levels with a dinner break at 7:15 p.m.
- Day 2 will resume at 3:00 p.m. the following day.
- Any player who has not taken a hand by the end of the registration period may be considered a “no show.” These players may have their chips removed from play and will not be eligible to participate.
- The Tournament Director in his sole and absolute discretion may alter the break schedule and stop times as necessary and/or add a Day 2 if necessary.
- The winner will receive a WSOP Circuit ring.
- All “ring” events qualify to earn points for the Circuit National Championship.
- All General Poker and Tournament Rules and Pay-outs apply.
- The Mississippi Gaming Commission reserves the right to investigate any and all complaints and disputes regarding tournaments, promotions, and drawings. Such disputes and complaints will be resolved in accordance with the Mississippi Gaming Control Act and Mississippi Gaming Commission.
- Management reserves the right to cancel, change, or modify the tournament, promotion, or drawing with prior notification to the Mississippi Gaming Commission, but must do so at least three (3) days prior to the commencement of the activity.
