- Day 2 will resume on September 12th at 3:00 PM.
- Winner will receive a WSOP gold ring.
- All "ring" events qualify to earn points for the 2017 WSOP Global Casino Championship.
- This is a re-entry event. If a player is eliminated during registration period that player may re-enter same event.
- There will be a 15-minute break after levels 4, 8, 12, 14, 17, 20, 22, 24, 26, and 28.
- Registration will remain open until the beginning of level 9.
