HOW TO PLAY

- Entry fee is \$500
- Each contestant will make 12 individual \$100 contest **win** wagers per day (mythical wagers) at selected race tracks. Tracks will be designated. Contestants may play any races from the designated tracks. Contest tracks will be determined six weeks prior to the start of the contest
- More than one horse may be selected per race, but each wager must be for \$100 to **win**. Each \$100 wager is a separate bet and will count as one of the total 12 wagers for the day
- Quarter horse races will not be accepted as contest bets. No "must go" entry or "must go" turf wagers will be accepted
- Contest points will be based on full track odds for the first \$20. The remainder of the wager will be credited at a maximum of 19-1. For example: If a horse pays \$100 to win the contestant will receive 2600 in points, \$1000 for the first \$20 and \$1600 for the remaining \$80
- Scratches earn no points and must be re-bet. Any unused wagers at the end of the day will be worth zero points and will not be credited, refunded or carried over
- ENTRIES and FIELDS go as a single wagering interest
- Points totals accumulate for three days
- Contestants must be 21 years of age or older
- Partners, Corporations, LTD's, INC's and LLC's are not allowed. Contestants are signed up and entered into the contest/tournament as an individual person and must provide identification and social security number/TIN number for required payouts
