

# HOLD 'EM ROYAL FLUSH PROMOTION

**February 1-29, 2012**

1. Promotion begins at Midnight on Wednesday, February 1st, 2012.
2. Daily qualifying period is from midnight until 11:59 p.m.
3. There will be \$2,000 in the "Royal Flush" pot each day in February. A total of \$58,000 will be awarded during this promotion.
4. If only one "Royal Flush" hand is made during the daily qualifying period, the player making the hand will receive the entire amount in the pot. If more than one player makes a "Royal Flush" during the daily qualifying period, the day's pot will be split evenly amongst all players making a "Royal Flush".
5. If a "Royal Flush" is not made during the daily qualifying period, the pot for that day will be carried over into the next day's qualifying period, and will be added to that day's pot. The carryover will continue until a "Royal Flush" hand is made. Again, one winner will receive the entire pot, and multiple winners will split the pot evenly.
6. If there is a carryover at the end of the qualifying period on February 29th, 2012, the promotion will continue until the first "Royal Flush" hand is made. The current pot amount at the end of the qualifying period on February 29th, 2012 will remain the same, and there will be no additional monies added.
7. A player may not win more than one share during a qualifying period with multiple winners, regardless of how many "Royal Flushes" he/she makes.
8. Must be playing in a "live" game to be eligible.
9. Players must utilize both hole cards in order to make a "Royal Flush".
10. Any discussion or collusion during a deal involving a "Royal Flush" hand may disqualify its eligibility.
11. Must be 21 years of age or older to gamble, and/or participate in this promotion.
12. Winnings of \$600 or more are taxable, and will require the patron to present a valid I.D., and Social Security card/number.
13. Orleans Poker Room general rules apply.
14. Management reserves the right to cancel, amend, or extend this promotion at its sole discretion, and without prior notice.
15. Any dispute or situation not covered by these rules shall be resolved by Property's Management in a manner that is fair to all parties. If the patron is not satisfied with Management's decision, he/she may exercise their rights under NRS. 463.362 et eq. and request the Nevada Gaming Control Board to review the matter.
