# "HOLD’EM HIGH HAND OF THE HOUR" 

Begins January $1^{\text {st }}, 2014$

- Monies will be awarded to the Texas Hold'em High Hand of the hour each day from 2am - 8am.
- The hourly qualifying period is from the top of each hour, through :59 minutes after each hour. Time will be established for a high hand when the dealer calls the hand out. If the call is made from the top of the hour through 59 minutes after, it will qualify for the current hour. If not, it will qualify for the next hour.
- $\quad \$ 100$ will be awarded if the high hand of the hour is made in a $\$ 4-\$ 8$ Limit Hold'em game, or a No Limit game. $\$ 50$ will be awarded if the hand is made in a $\$ 2-\$ 4$ Limit Hold'em game.
- This promotion applies to "live" Texas Hold'em cash games only.
- Any Aces full or better qualifies. If the minimum qualifying hand is not met during the hour, the monies will be carried over to the next hour. If the hand is made in a \$2-\$4 game, it will go up by $\mathbf{\$ 5 0}$. If it is made in $\mathbf{\$ 4} \mathbf{\$ 8}$ or No Limit game, it will go up by $\mathbf{\$ 1 0 0 .}$. The monies will carry over until a winning qualifying hand is made.
- Must use both hole cards to make the best possible five card hand.
- In the event of a tie, kickers will count for four of a kinds, and suits will determine the winner for straight and royal flushes (club, diamond, heart, spade from lowest to highest). If a tie occurs in any other situation, the prize will be divided equally.
- A player making a potential qualifying hand must notify the dealer and/or a supervisor immediately upon completion of the hand. Failure to do so may disqualify the hand's eligibility.
- All qualifying hands will be documented and maintained at the poker podium in order of succession.
- The winning high hand will be announced at the end of each hour's qualifying period.
- Winners will have seven (7) days to collect their prize. Should the winner fail to collect within seven (7) days, the prize monies will be returned to the promotional pool.
- Proper I.D. is required for all payouts. Social Security card/number is required for payouts of $\$ 600$ or more.
- Orleans general poker room general rules apply in addition to these rules.
- Orleans Poker Team Members are not eligible.
- Management reserves the right to cancel, or amend this promotion at its sole discretion, and without prior notice.
- Any dispute or situation not covered by these rules shall be resolved by the property's Management in a manner that is fair to all parties. If the patron is not satisfied with Management's decision, he/she may exercise their rights under NRS 463.362 et eq., and request the Nevada Gaming Control Board to review the matter.
