Daily Poker Tournament Rules

1. All participants must be 21 years of age or older.
2. Daily tournaments begin at 12:05am and 7:05pm daily. Daily tournaments may be canceled during special events and/or holidays. Starting times may also be subject to change.
3. Tournament buy-ins range from \$50 to \$125.
4. Tournament entry fees range from \$15 to \$25 depending upon the buy-in. Entry fees are withheld to cover costs associated with the tournament such as beverage service, staffing, and tournament promotional funding.
5. Starting chip amounts range from 5,000 to 12,500, depending upon the buy-in. For tournaments with add-ons, 5,000 in chips will be given for the add-on.
6. For specified tournaments, a single add-on may be taken any time from the start of the tournament, through the end of the first break.
7. Re-entries are allowed in all tournaments through the end of the first break only. Re-entries will be assigned a seat promptly if there are seats available. If an alternate list exists, re-entries will be placed at the bottom of the alternate list. Note: Only one (1) re-entry is allowed through the end of the first break for the \$125 NL tournament on Thursday at 12:05 pm.
8. Players are eliminated from the tournament once all of their starting chips have been relinquished, their add-on has been exhausted (if applicable), and the re-entry period has ended.
9. Tournament structures are posted in the Poker Room and on the tournament schedule.
10. Player agreements regarding prize pool payouts (chops & paying additional places) are permissible (only from prize pool & bounty), as long as the agreement is unanimously and willingly decided upon by all remaining participants. Players that are paid with bounty money will not receive points towards the TPOM.
11. As players are eliminated from the tournament, the tournament floor will keep the tables balanced according to Orleans tournament procedures.
12. A form W2-G will be issued to those that net more than \$5,000. The buy-in amount is deducted from the winnings. Non-resident aliens are subject to a 30% withholding, and will be issued a form 1042s.
13. All winners must produce a valid I.D. and social security card/number for net winnings of more than \$5,000, minus the buy-in.
14. Management reserves the right to limit the number of entrants based on table availability.
15. Management reserves the right to cancel, or make revisions to daily tournaments and structures at its sole discretion, and without prior notice.
16. Penalties may be imposed to anyone found not in compliance with Orleans general rules, tournament rules, and/or inappropriate behavior. If the issuance of penalties do not provide corrective action, an individual may be subject to disqualification, at the discretion of the tournament floorperson. A disqualified patron will forfeit all monies he/she has contributed, as well as rights to any portion of the prize pool.
17. Any dispute or situation not covered by these rules shall be resolved by the property's management in a manner that is fair to all parties. If the patron is not satisfied with management's decision, he/she may exercise their rights under NRS 463.362 et eq., and request the Nevada gaming control board to review the matter.
