



BOWLING BAR'S SQUARES BIG GAME FOOTBALL RULES

1. This promotion takes place only at the Suncoast's Bowling Bar.
2. Players must be 21 years or older and have a B Connected Club card.
3. Hit a four-of-a-kind with a quarter (.25) or higher denomination and win one-entry on The Bowling Bar's Big Game Football Squares. The four-of-a-kind must have no wild cards and must be a maximum coin bet. The professional televised football game on February 5, 2012 will be used for the square game.
4. Entries are available until the board is filled.
5. A valid ID and a B Connected Card are needed to gain an entry.
6. It is the player's responsibility to notify the Bartender before playing off the four-of-kind to earn a spot on the game board. (NO RECALLS) The Bartender will be the verifier.
7. The player will pick an available square and the Bartender will mark the square with the player's name and club number.
8. Winners receive downloadable Slot Dollars and based on the last digit of the score for each team playing. The position on the game board determines the entry's team and digits.
9. Example: If the score of the game is 14-7 then the 4/7 square is the winner.
10. Downloadable prizes amounts per quarter:

1st Quarter = \$125-downloadable Slot Dollars
2nd Quarter = \$250-downloadable Slot Dollars
3rd Quarter = \$125-downloadable Slot Dollars
4th Quarter = \$250-downloadable Slot Dollars
11. Teams will be listed and numbers will be drawn after all squares are covered. This will take place 15 minutes prior to kick off.
12. At the end of each quarter, the Bartender will notify a Slot Supervisor, who will verify the winner's name and B Connected Club card number.
13. The Slot Supervisor will present the bonus coupon to B Connect Club Supervisor to add downloadable play. (Non-Transferable)
14. Downloadable Slot Dollars winning are valid for 72-hours starting at the end of the Big Game.
15. All participants agree to grant Boyd Gaming unconditional use of their name and likeness for promotional use without compensation, consideration, notice review or consent.
16. Entries will be retained for record keeping purposes in accordance with company policy and legal requirements.
17. Any dispute or situation not covered by these rules shall be resolved by the property's management in a manner that is fair to all parties. If the patron is not satisfied with management decision, he or she may exercise their right under NRS 463.361 et. eq. and request the Nevada Gaming Control Board to review the matter.
