## KENO TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Sam's Town Hotel & Gambling Hall Keno Rules prevail except otherwise noted.
2. Players may re-enter for an additional entry fee of \$500 per entry (UN-LIMITED RE-ENTRY).
3. Tournament play must be completed prior to re-entry.
4. Each re-entry will be considered separately in determining the winner.
5. All \$500 in Tournament money must be played before the end of the Tournament at 1:30 p.m. Unused Tournament money may not be redeemed for cash.
6. No one (1) or two (2) spots on straight tickets. They may be played on way tickets max .50\$ per way. Players can play any other ticket currently offered at Sam's Town Hotel & Gambling Hall.
7. Minimum bet per straight ticket is one-dollar (\$1.00) and way tickets may be played 3 ways or more for fifty cents (.50) per way or 10 ways or more for twenty-five cents (.25) per way. No ten cent (.10) way tickets.
8. Minimum of (10) game multi-tickets until after 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday. 5 Game minimum until the last 5 games. Any unused tournament money may be played to complete a player's entry. **It is the player's responsibility to keep track of money wagered on tournament accounts.**
9. At the end of tournament play, the contestants with the highest win total will be declared the first place winner. The contestant with the second highest win total will be declared the second place winner and so on.
10. In the event of a tie, each contestant will pick a 20 spot on the 1<sup>st</sup> game following the tournament. The player that catches the most numbers wins. Standings will then move down one place.
11. Tournament players must present their Tournament barcode with any new ticket played and make sure that the correct Tournament account number is on their ticket. Tournament account number mistakes are not reconcilable, regardless of fault. No manual adjustments can be made in the computer system. In case of such an error, the amounts reflected in the Keno Computer will be used regardless of the amount of tournament scrip in possession of entrants.
12. Standings will be posted hourly.
13. Tournament play will be from Monday at 5:30 p.m. until Wednesday at 1:30 p.m.
14. No tickets may be played on a straight or way ticket, which exceeds a wager of more than \$10.00 per way.
15. The deadline for re-buys is Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. No new entrants or re-buys will be accepted after this time.
16. **Keno Bucks will be issued in \$10 increments.**
17. Employees are not eligible to participate in promotions or tournaments.
18. Boyd may disqualify any person for any prize based upon fraud, dishonesty, violation of tournament rules or other misconduct whether or not related to this tournament.
19. The Mississippi Gaming Commission reserves the right to investigate any and all complaints and disputes regarding tournaments, promotions and drawings. Such disputes and complaints will be resolved in accordance with the Mississippi Gaming Control Act and Mississippi Gaming Commission Regulations.
20. Management reserves the right to cancel, change or modify the tournament, promotion or drawing with prior notification to the Mississippi Gaming Commission, but must do so at least three (3) days prior to the commencement of the activity.
