

### Feeling Flush? Well, here's your game.

High Card Flush was voted Best New Table Game at the 2012 Raving's Cutting Edge Table Games Conference. The judges included respected table games operators and industry experts.

High Card Flush was also voted the winner of Casino Enterprise Management's 2013 International Table Games Award. Judges consisted of a panel of Casino Operations Executives.

The game is simple to play and deal. Both the players and the dealer receive seven cards each. Players are hoping to receive all, or many of these cards in the same suit. Players win their primary wager consisting of the Ante and Raise wager if they receive more cards in the same suit than the dealer.

In the event both player and dealer have the same number of cards in their Flush (i.e., a four-card flush) the winner is decided by the highest ranking card. An exact copy is a push.

No understanding of poker or poker strategy is needed.

Two proposition bets that offer big payouts.

- House Advantage:**

Ante and Raise Bets ...**2.64%**

Flush Proposition Wager (15 Paytables) ...**4.0% - 11.08%**

Straight Flush Wager (8 Paytables) ...**6.27% - 13.09%**

- Hit Frequency:**

Ante and Raise ...**Approximately 1 in 2 Hands**  
(2.64 house advantage)

Flush Wager ...**1 in 4.5 Hands**

Straight Flush Wager ...**1 in 14.3 hands**
