

HOW TO PLAY ROULETTE



THE ACTION-PACKED WHEEL OF CHANCE!

Roulette, the game associated with the plush gambling capitals of Europe, is right at home at the Diamond Jo Casino! It's exciting and easy to play.

CHIP

Roulette chips are different from other casino chips because they vary in denomination and color. Each player receives a different color chip.

HOW TO PLAY

Play begins when the players have placed most of their bets by putting their chips on the numbered layout. The dealer spins the Roulette ball in the opposite direction of the spinning wheel. Bets may be placed until the dealer announces "no more bets." After the ball falls onto a number on the wheel, the dealer places a marker on the winning number on the table layout and pays the winning bets.

(Over Please)

THERE ARE MANY WAYS TO BET ON THE ROULETTE TABLE

HOW THE BETS ARE PLACED

Single 0 or 00
Played the same as single number bets. Pays 35 to 1.

0-00 Split
Pays 17 to 1.

Four Numbers or Corner
Covers four joining numbers. Pays 8 to 1.

Five Numbers
Covers 0, 00, 1, 2, 3 only. Pays 6 to 1.

Six Numbers or Six Lines
Covers six numbers across. Pays 5 to 1.

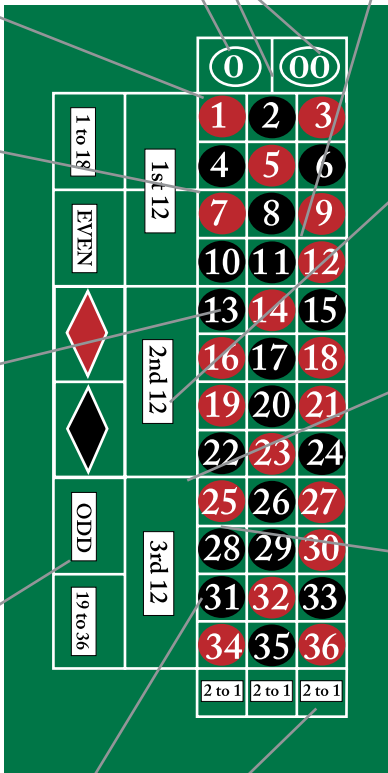
Single Number
Play any straight up number including 0 or 00. Pays 35 to 1.

Twelve Numbers or Dozen
Covers all 12 numbers in that section. Pays 2 to 1.

0 - 00 Split
Place bet here for convenience. Pays 17 to 1.

Even Money Bets
Black, Red, Even, Odd, 1 to 18, 19 to 36. Pays 1 to 1.

Two Numbers or Split
Covers both numbers. Pays 17 to 1.



Three numbers
Covers the three numbers across. (example: 31, 32, 33) Pays 11 to 1.

Column Bets
Covers each column of 12 numbers. Pays 2 to 1.
