

HOW TO PLAY **PAI GOW POKER**



A FUN, FAST-PACED VARIATION OF TRADITIONAL POKER!

Pai Gow is played with seven cards that make the best two poker hands possible. The highest hand has five cards and the second highest hand has two cards. To win you must beat both of the dealer's hands. A commission of 5% is paid on all winning hands.

BONUS WAGER

A bonus wager may be made at the same time a bet is wagered. The bonus bet can be \$1.00 to \$50.00 max. A bonus wager of \$5.00 or more qualifies for the envy bonus, which entitles the guest to win on other guests' hands. An envy button will be placed next to the wager. An envy bonus won due to another player's hand is paid accordingly to the envy bonus pay scale.

FORTUNE PAI GOW PAY CHART:

Straight	2 to 1
3 of a Kind	3 to 1
Flush.....	4 to 1
Full House.....	5 to 1
4 of a Kind	25 to 1
Straight Flush.....	50 to 1
Royal Flush	150 to 1
Five Aces.....	400 to 1
7- Card Straight Flush With Joker	1000 to 1
Royal Flush & Royal Match	2000 to 1
(Royal Match - K & Q Suited)	
7- Card Straight Flush - No Joker.....	8000 to 1

ENVY BONUS:

4 of a Kind	\$5.00
Straight Flush.....	\$20.00
Royal Flush	\$50.00
Five Aces.....	\$250.00
7- Card Straight Flush With Joker	\$500.00
Royal Flush & Royal Match	\$1000.00
7- Card Straight Flush - No Joker.....	\$5000.00

- Maximum aggregate payout is \$25,000.
- Any bonus payoff of \$100 or more needs a Supervisor's approval.
- Guests' hands are reconstructed to the highest possible bonus hand.
- The bet is pushed out of the betting circle once it's paid.
