**Promotion Name:** \$100 High Hands

**Promotion Dates:** Monday - Thursday in July. July 1 - 25, 2019

**Promotion Times:** 9:00pm until 2:00pm

(Winners awarded every hour 10:00am, 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm, 2:00pm)

**Promotion Rules:** Beginning at 9:00am, (first game of the day must be started by 9:30am to qualify the 10:00am payout.) all seated Texas Hold 'Em players will have the chance to be dealt the high hand of the hour. A player must have a full house or better using both their hole cards, to qualify. Player must win the pot. A tie or chopped pot is not a win. There must be a minimum of \$20 in the pot.

Once the first high hand is announced, the Card Room Supervisor or Card Room Manager will verify the hand and record it on a board within the room, which can be seen by all the poker players. The Card Room Supervisor or Card Room Manager will list the actual hand along with the leading player's name. The posted hand will be the target for all the other players to beat during the hour.

At 10:00am, 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm and 2:00pm, the player with the highest hand will be awarded \$100, and the next hour will begin immediately. If no player qualifies with a full house or better using both of their hole cards, then the \$100 will carry over to the next hour, making the next hour's total \$200. (Example: If at 12:00p there is no winner, the poker room will carry over the \$100 pay out to 1:00pm which will now be worth \$200. In the event the last session has no winner the session will continue until a player qualifies).

**Promotion Details:** All monies paid during this promotion will be paid from the poker promotional fund. The Card Room Supervisor or Card Room Manager will fill out a prize certificate form. They will have the winner sign it. The prize certificate will be placed in the poker cash drawer to account for the payout. At the end of the gaming day the certificate will be sent to audit to reconcile the bank.

- All applicable taxes are the responsibility of the winner. The Kansas Star Casino will be responsible for all required tax reporting and documentation.
- Employees of the Kansas Star and their immediate families are not eligible for this promotion.
- Management reserves the right to change any rules with the approval of the Kansas Lottery and the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission.
- The Kansas Star reserves the right to cancel the promotion up to 48 hours in advance with prior approval from the Kansas Lottery and the KRGC.
- Anyone enrolled in the Kansas Voluntary Exclusion Program is not eligible for this tournament.
- Must be 21 years of age or older to participate.
- Winners will be required to show valid government-issued picture identification.
- All decisions made by supervisors are final.
