



HOW TO PLAY

ROULETTE

THE ACTION-PACKED WHEEL *of* CHANCE

Roulette, the game associated with the plush gambling capitals of Europe, is right at home at the Kansas Star Casino! It's exciting and easy to play.

CHIPS

Roulette chips are different from other casino chips because they vary in denomination and color. Each player receives different colored chips. Those chips can only be used and cashed in at that table.

HOW *to* PLAY

Play begins when the players have placed most of their bets on the numbered layout. The dealer spins the Roulette

ball in the opposite direction of the spinning wheel. Bets may be placed until the dealer announces "no more bets." After the ball falls onto a number on the wheel, the dealer places a marker on the winning number on the table layout and pays the winning bets.

HOW TO PLAY



HOW *the* BETS ARE PLACED

Single 0 or 00

Played the same as single number bets. Pays 35 to 1.

Five Numbers

Covers 0, 00, 1, 2, 3 only. Pays 6 to 1.

Six Numbers

Covers six numbers in succession. Pays 5 to 1.

Single Number

Play any straight up number including 0 or 00. Pays 35 to 1.

Even Money Bets

Black, Red, Even, Odd, 1 to 18, 19 to 36. Pays 1 to 1.

0-00 Split

Pays 17 to 1.

Four Numbers or Corner

Covers four joining numbers. Pays 8 to 1.

Twelve Numbers or Dozen

Covers all 12 numbers in that section. Pays 2 to 1.

0-00 Split

Place bet here for convenience. Pays 17 to 1.

Two Numbers or Split



Covers both numbers. Pays 17 to 1.

Three Numbers

Covers the three numbers across. *Example: 31, 32, 33.* Pays 11 to 1.

Column Bets

Covers each column of 12 numbers. Pays 2 to 1.
