

LUCKY MONEY BACCARAT



TOURNAMENT RULES

Wednesdays, October 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th, & 31st

- 1. Entry into the tournament will be \$25 and is non-refundable. Players may register first come/first serve from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on the day of the tournament in Pit 3 (by the Copper Whisk Café). Sessions will be filled in order. After the tournament is filled, no further registrations will be taken. The tournament will be conducted in 3 rounds of play at 8 p.m., 9 p.m. and 10 p.m. Players will be assigned to one 30 hand session in each round. Positions will be assigned in order and may be changed by casino management when necessary to even up the tables. The semi-final round will be at 11 p.m. Final round will be at 12 midnight.
- 2. Players must be at least 21 years of age and present a valid photo ID. Players must also be a B-Connected Member. There are no player substitutions allowed.
- 3. The prize package is a guarantee \$3000 for the Lucky Money Tournament. The winner of the Lucky Money Tournament will receive a guarantee of at least \$2000 and the 2nd through 6th place winners will receive a guarantee of at least \$200.
- 4. Once the entry fee total is reached to support the prize package of \$3000 for the Lucky Money Tournament, any additional entry fees will be subject to a 10% administration charge. All additional funds would be given to the overall winner of the tournament.
- 5. Each participant will be issued a table assignment card which must be presented to the dealer at the start of session play along with a valid photo ID and their B-Connected card. We recommend a player be 5 minute early to the tournament table at the start of the session. If a player is not on time for the start of their session, they will automatically be disqualified from the session. The pit computer clock will be used to determine start time.
- 6. Specially designed tournament chips will be used during tournament play and these chips may not be removed from the table nor exchanged between players. At the end of each session, the player's scores will be recorded on a table card. Players are asked not to leave the table until they are satisfied the amount entered on the card represents their actual score. A player may not leave the tournament table until the player is eliminated or at the completion of the session.
- 7. There will be 30 hands in each session. Each player must make a player **OR** banker bet on each hand. The player cannot make both a player and banker bet on the same hand. Betting limits are from \$100 to \$3000 and all bets must be made in \$100 increments. There are no Tie Bet Wagers permitted during Tournament Play. All players begin each session with \$3000 in tournament chips.
- 8. A die will be used to determine the starting position of the first bet. The betting order will be rotated after each hand. A marker will be used to indicate which player is first to bet. All action will proceed clockwise from that player. The first bet marker will be moved clockwise to the next player after each hand.

- 9. Chips not in play must be kept in clear view in front of each player. The chips must be stacked separately by denominations so that they can be easy to read by other players. They may be only handled by placing or collecting bets. Once a bet has been placed in the betting circle, it may not be changed. (No string betting is allowed)
- 10. No items other than chips, drinks, scorecards and pens are allowed on the table.
- 11. There will be a single winner from each table at the 8 p.m., 9 p.m. and 10 p.m. sessions who will advance to the semi-final round. There will be two winners from each table on the semi-final round who will advance to the final table.
- 12. In the event of a tie between two or more players at the end of a session, we will deal additional hands until the tie is broken and we have a winner. We will roll the die to determine the first wager of the tie-breaker round.
- 13. Normal Orleans Mini Baccarat rules will apply except as changed herein.
- 14. The Casino will not collect commission during tournament play.
- 15. Conversing with the spectators will be cause for disqualification. Spectators who interfere with the game or provide assistance to players will be subject to eviction. Players are not permitted to discuss baccarat strategies with other players, dealers or casino personnel. Players are not permitted to borrow, lend or give their tournament chips to another player.
- 16. Players not adhering to the rules may be disqualified at the discretion of the casino management. Disqualified players will not share in any prizes or awards. In the event of a dispute during play, the decision of the casino management will be final. The Orleans reserves the right to accept or deny any entry into the tournament without cause.
- 17. Re-buys into the tournament will be permitted based on availability and will only be accepted by the actual player. Each rebuy entry into the tournament will be an additional \$25 and is non-refundable.
- 18. There will be an unofficial count of chips per player at the 25-hand mark for player convenience.
- 19. The Orleans reserves the right to change or amend the tournament structure and/or prize package at any time.
- 20. The Orleans management reserves the right to cancel, alter, or modify any or all aspects of this tournament at any time. Orleans employees are prohibited from entry into this tournament. Family members and members of Orleans employees' households may enter if other qualifications are met. Management will attempt to resolve any patron dispute to the satisfaction of both parties. Any dispute or situation not covered by these rules shall be resolved by the property's management in a manner that is fair to all parties. If the patron is not satisfied with management's decision, he or she may exercise their rights under NRS 463.635 et. Seq. and request the Nevada Gaming Control Board to review the matter. Management reserves all rights.
