Official Rules

- 1. Participants must be at least 21 years old and a valid B Connected Club card member. Entries based on use of B Connected card. Play without a B Connected card does not qualify. Membership in B Connected is free and available at a B Connected Club.
- 2. Participants may earn football squares beginning on October 1, 2018 at 12:01am and ending when the game board is completed for the following Sunday evening game. Squares may also be earned each week going forward through the final Sunday game in November.
- 3. Players playing a minimum bet of \$5, having one of these hand will win a square:
 - a. Every dealt suited Blackjack in Spades (first 2 cards)
 - b. Progressive Pai Gow: 4 of a kind or better
 - c. Three Card Poker: Straight flush or better
 - d. Craps: Any parlayed all day hardway that wins earns one square.

You must parlay again and win to earn an additional square.

Players meeting one of the above requirements on a Tuesday or Wednesday will receive an additional square.

- 4. When a player earns a square, their name and B Connected number will be added to the Sunday game board.
- 5. The game board squares will be for the NBC 5:30pm kickoff Sunday night games, beginning October 7, 2018.
- 6. Teams will be listed and numbers drawn by Table Games supervision 10 minutes prior to kick-off. Once the selection process starts, players may not earn a space on the board.
- 7. The last digit of each team's score will determine the square that is the winner. The player with that ,square wins the quarter prize. Example: Red team 6 and Blue team 4. At the end of the quarter, Red scores ending in 6 and Blue scores ending in 4 would make that square a winner (e.g. Red 6, Blue 14). Scores are deemed official from the NFL website.
- 8. Each first quarter prize begins at \$150. Each second quarter prize begins at \$250. Each third quarter prize begins at \$450. Each forth quarter prize begins at \$650. Unclaimed prizes are rolled over and added to the same quarter the following week. There are four quarter prizes per game. No overtime prizes.
- 9. Must be present to win and winners must present their VALID PHOTO ID and valid B Connected card. Winning players will have two minutes to claim their prizes at the quarter's end. If a player is unable or ineligible to claim a prize, that prize is added to the same quarter the next week creating a progressive prize.
- 10. All entries will be removed from the game board after the game had concluded. New entries are available to be earned Mondays. Any unclaimed quarter prizes after the last game of the promotion period will be awarded via a drawing after the game. The names on the game board will be the entrants in the drawing. Selected name(s) will have two minutes to claim their prize.
- 11. Entries are not transferable. Entries go on the board with each qualifying hand.
- 12. Winners must give consent to use their name and image for promotional purposes.
- 13. Winners are responsible for any and all applicable taxes.
- 14. Accumulative winnings over \$600 will receive a \$1099 tax form.
- 15. Management reserves the right to modify or cancel this promotion at its sole discretion and at any time. This includes awarding prizes for shortened, substitute or postponed games.
